<u>Cancellations & Refund Process</u>— Please contact Darcy as soon as possible to cancel your reservation. The stand by list will be utilized to try and fill your reservation. **Feel free to contact friends or family to take your spot.** If we cannot find a replacement, a refund will be given in the amount returned from our tour company, usually live performance tickets, meals, prepaid tours are non-refundable.

Motorcoach Seating—Motorcoach seating is on the first come/first seated basis. Assigned/reserved seating will be at the front of the coach for those travelers who have mobility or medical issues. Please mention your needs when making your reservation. Otherwise it is first come/first seated. Remember access to the coach will start 10-15 minutes prior to departure. In Waterloo, please wait for the bank representative to invite you to load the coach.

<u>Payment Options</u>—Payment is required to secure your day trip reservation. Payment can be made by check, cash or debiting an FNB account.

We'll see the World's Largest Mailbox, which stands more than 32 feet tall and can hold over 5,000 cubic feet of mail! Visitors can climb into the mailbox and watch the red flag raise! Next it's on to the World's Largest Rocking Chair. Made mostly of recycled material, all the wood was salvaged from old telephone poles and metal pipes that were once used to transfer oil. Across the street from the rocking chair, see the World's Largest Wind Chime. The beautifully landscaped steel wind chime measures a total of 55 ft in height. The four steel pipe chimes vary in length creating their own unique sound. Visitors can ring the chimes, weather permitting. Next door, you can visit and shop at Whittling Whimsy.
