<u>Securing Multi-Day Tour reservations</u>— Reservations are secured with submission of necessary documents **and** the deposit. First come, first registered.

<u>Cancellations & Refund Process</u>— Please contact Darcy as soon as possible to cancel your reservation. The stand by list will be utilized to try and fill your reservation. **Feel free to contact friends or family to take your spot.** If we cannot find a replacement, a refund will be given in the amount returned from our tour company, usually live performance tickets, meals, prepaid activities & tours are non-refundable

Motorcoach Seating—Motorcoach seating is on the first come, first seated basis. Assigned/reserved seating will be at the front of the coach for those travelers who have mobility or medical issues. Please mention your needs when making your reservation. Otherwise it is first come/first seated. Remember access to the coach will start 15 minutes prior to departure. In Waterloo, please wait for the bank representative to invite you to load the coach.

<u>Payment Options</u>—Payment is required to secure your day trip reservation. Payment can be made by check, cash or debiting an FNB account.

<u>Entrée Choices</u>—If entrées are listed in the trip description, please provide your choice when making your reservation. Also, please give any food allergies or meal restrictions (i.e.: gluten free, vegetarian, vegan)
